


WHAT IT'S USED FOR The improved clinch knot is used to tie line to a hook or a lure

PALOMAR KNOT

WHAT IT'S USED FOR The palomar knot is used to tie line to a hook or a lure

INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO TIE IT



TURLE KNOT

WHAT IT'S USED FOR

The turle knot is used for tying line to hooks and lures (good for thin lines and small hooks)

INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO TIE IT




BLOOD KNOT

WHAT IT'S USED FOR The blood knot is used to tie two lines together. It is best to use this knot for lines of similar diameters

INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO TIE IT

- 3 Slowly pull the standing lines in opposite directions until the knot is tight



SNELL KNOT

WHAT IT'S USED FOR The snell knot is used to tie line to a hook

INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO TIE IT

- Pass the line through the hook eye, then fold it down on itself so you create a loop near the bottom of the hook
- Pull the standing line and tag end to tighten the knot
